- ① **Program Name:** Department of Global Convergence (three tracks: Korean / English / Chinese)
- ② **Majors:** Global Business / Global Media & Communication / Global Performing Arts & Content / Global Industrial Technology

- ③ **Program Features:** Bilingual curriculum adopted

※ Bilingual curriculum: A program separately established, in which at least 50% of the graduation credits are completed in a foreign language other than Korean.

- ④ **Descriptions of the Majors**

- A. Global Media & Communication:** A major designed to cover theories and practices in media and communication, the core of the information society. The goal is to foster communication experts in new media promotion by reflecting the demands of the press and media (newspapers, broadcasting, film), the Internet, mobile technologies, advanced information and communication technology, and the digital industry.
- B. Global Business:** A major aimed at cultivating global business professionals equipped with global insight, creative thinking, and an understanding of the global business environment, enabling them to remain competitive in a rapidly changing world. The program emphasizes systematic foreign language education, integrating theory and practice to strengthen applied skills and adaptability in real-world business contexts.
- C. Global Industrial Technology:** A program providing education to develop professional competencies in popular and applied music fields such as K-Pop, K-Dance, and K-Production, along with related music arts professions. Through systematic theory and extensive practical training, the goal is to nurture world-class experts in popular music, interdisciplinary artists who bridge music and technology, and globally competitive musicians.

- [9]** For students applying for a visa at a diplomatic mission abroad, a standard school enrollment permit will be sent.
- [10]** If an admitted student is unable to enroll due to unavoidable circumstances or decides not to enroll, they may receive a refund of tuition fees in accordance with the university policy.
 - ※ **New students will be provided a full refund of the tuition if they decide not to register before the official enrollment date. If they withdraw after the enrollment date, the tuition will be refunded after subtracting the amount corresponding to the number of class days attended from the enrollment date to the withdrawal date.**
- [11]** All admitted students must enroll in accident insurance, effective from the date of entry into Korea, to cover any potential accidents or illnesses during their stay. (The insurance must be maintained throughout their studies.) According to the National Health Insurance Act, international students are automatically enrolled as regional subscribers of the National Health Insurance, as of March 2021.

- [14]** If the documents submitted by the applicant do not provide sufficient information for verification, additional documents may be requested, and applicants failing to submit requested documents will be rejected.
- [15]** **Regardless of the campus, applications can only be submitted once per session. If multiple applications are submitted, subsequent applications will be excluded for reasons of failure to meet the eligibility requirements. (If discovered, admission will be cancelled even after enrollment.)**
- [16]** The applicant's personal information will only be used for the purposes specified below and be properly disposed of at the end of the retention period. (In the case of applicants who register with the university, this information will be used for academic records.)

 - A. The Korean Language Training Program at Kangwon National University is designed for foreigners who want to study Korean in a structured and systematic way.
